*Two part-time graduate students were inadvertently omitted from the initial Fall 2012 12th day headcount because of a data entry error in PeopleSoft. The 2012 figures have been re-stated to include these two students.

**The F.T.E. calculation for Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) students changed in Fall 2013 from credit hours taken divided by 9 to credit hours taken divided by 5. This change was necessary to match the IPEDS F.T.E. for DNP students and resulted in a substantial change in the overall and graduate F.T.E. count. Likewise, Doctor of Nursing Practice students taking 5 or more credit hours are counted as Full-Time for headcount purposes rather than Part-Time starting in Fall 2013. This change has resulted in a substantial shift in the Full-Time/Part-Time distribution of graduate students compared to prior years.
